Departure: Friday 22nd June

- Students must arrive at 8.10am, and ready for registration for 8.20am on Friday 22nd June 2018.
- We will be leaving the school at 10.30am by coach.

Arrival: Monday 25th June

- We will be returning to school for approximately 6pm on Monday 25th June 2018.
- All students **must be collected** by their parent/carer or a responsible adult from school at the front entrance on Meadowcourt Road.
- Please remember, that you must not park on Meadowcourt Road under any circumstances. Please support and respect the resident. Thank you for supporting us with this request.

Passports and European Health Card

Please continue to drop your child's passport and European Health card. If you wish you may bring these details with you on Thursday June 7th.

Your child's passport and EH card must given to Ms Douillet by Thursday 14th June 2018.

Important Information

If your child requires any medication on the trip, please put it in a plastic wallet with her/ his name on it and bring it into school in the morning of the trip on Friday 22nd June 2018

E.g. Travel sickness tablets, inhalers, cold/ cough medicine, migraine tablets, etc.

If you have any queries please contact the school prior to departure, students must not carry their own medication.

Mobile phones

Mobile phones are not allowed on the trip. This is for safety and to prevent misuse of social media and any issues that may arise using a mobile phone. Please support us with this expectation. Phones will be confiscated, if this expectation is not adhered to. We understand that you may need to contact your child and want regular updates.

Parents/Guardians will be contacted in case of emergency.

What to bring

Clothing

There is a limit of one small suitcase per child and one piece of hand luggage for items needed on the coach journey. Students will not have access to their suitcases during the coach journey.

Students need to bring appropriate clothing and footwear on the school trip. For example:

- T-shirts, long-sleeved tops, hoodies, trainers, jeans, tracksuit bottoms and sportswear etc. Leggings must be worn with shorts.
- Waterproof jacket
- Footwear: trainers, comfortable flat shoes or waterproof shoes
- A wash bag (including, shower gel/soap, roll on deodorant, hair band if your child has long hair) and a towel. No aerosol deodorants or make up.
- Clearly marked plastic bag to contain dirty and wet clothing.
- Please mark all clothing with the student's name and bring sufficient change of clothes as laundry services will not be available.

Pocket money

Students will have the opportunity to buy souvenirs when we visit the towns of Dieppe and Le Tréport. It is recommended an allowance between 20 and 40 Euros is more than adequate for drinks, snacks and also for the souvenirs.

What not to bring

- Mobile phones, electronic gadgets and other valuables
- We strongly recommend that students do not bring any valuable items as the school will not be held responsible for any items that are lost or stolen on the trip.

Appliances

Students are responsible for the safety of their own appliances such as hairdryers. Other electrical appliances are not allowed e.g. Tablets and hair straighteners.

Students Role and Responsibilities

- Students must not leave the centre without a supervising adult
- Student must not enter the accommodation with other parties
- Students must not take any undue risks
- Students must follow the instructions of the leader and other supervisors including those at the venue

- No jewellery as it is a health and safety hazard
- The centre buildings, equipment and belongings should be handled with due care.
- Cost of damages will be charged to those responsible
- Adhere to our Student charter and the IB values.
